

Taoiseach and Minister Howlin meet with the Croke Park Implementation Body

The Implementation Body met with The Taoiseach, Mr. Enda Kenny T.D., and the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform, Mr. Brendan Howlin T.D., on 11th July, following the publication of the Body's second annual progress Report on 13th June last.

The meeting was a useful opportunity to review the progress that has been made to date under the Croke Park Agreement and the Taoiseach and Minister both acknowledged the savings that have been achieved as well as the important reform that is being delivered.

The Taoiseach and Minister also emphasised the challenges which still remain and the need to ensure that the Agreement delivers to its full potential over its remaining lifetime. The Chair emphasised the Body's commitment to driving the implementation of the Agreement in the period ahead.
