68. Deputy Eoghan Murphy asked the **Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform** his views on whether it is necessary to review the membership of the implementation body for the Croke Park Agreement in order that at least one of the body's members is from a non-public sector area. [24705/12]

Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform (Deputy Brendan Howlin): As is customary for industrial relations agreements, the membership of the Implementation Body is drawn from the parties to the Agreement and is specified under paragraph 1.18 of the Agreement which provides that the Body will comprise of an independent chair and nominees by Public Service Management and by the Public Services Committee of ICTU respectively.

Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform (Deputy Brendan Howlin): The Implementation Body for the *Public Service Agreement 2010-2014* is currently carrying out its second annual review of the Agreement in accordance with Paragraph 1.16 of the Agreement. I expect to receive the final report of the Implementation Body next month. It will be laid before the Houses of the Oireachtas and published shortly thereafter.
